

COVID-19 Protocol in the Classroom

Update for March 12, 2022

As of March 12, 2022, due to the state wide lifting of face coverings for schools by the State of California and regulations and recommendations of the California and Nevada Health Departments, SSU will not be enforcing masks inside the classrooms. Face coverings will be optional inside the classrooms and offices at SSU.

We highly recommend students on SSU premises to:

- 1) Get vaccinated against COVID-19 (with 3 doses as recommended by the Centers for Disease and Control and Prevention-CDC)

 Please consult your local health department or doctor.
- 2) Maintain a socially distant environment.
- 3) Frequently wash hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. When soap and running water are not immediately available, use an alcohol-based <u>hand sanitizer</u> with at least 60% ethanol or 70% isopropanol as active ingredients and rub hands together until they are dry. All SSU classrooms provide hand sanitizers.
- 4) <u>Do not eat food</u> in the classroom.
- 5) Stay home if sick.
